

Mid Season Report: August 2010

Boldmere Water Polo players are looking forward to an exciting end to the season, and with our 'A' team having two home matches left to complete our first ever season in the top flight of the Midland Water Polo League, we are looking for a top three finish. Our Youth team (U16) have three matches left, with a crucial home fixture against Solihull to determine who will come out top. Due to the pool closing for the installation of the boom, this fixture may have to be put back to the first week in October.

The Water Polo section have made good progress over the last twelve months, with the Senior players lifting the Combined West and East Midlands Championships, the Youth team (u16) retained the Youth Championship, and the Junior team (u18) regained the Junior championship. Our Senior Development Team is currently challenging Worcester and Aston for the Midland League Div 3 Championship its going to be a challenging end to the season!

What of the future?

Boldmere SC has have been instrumental in the formation of a new competition in order to take our Youth team into more challenging territory. Boldmere SC, Cheltenham S&WPC, Watford SC, and Grantham SC have formed a 4-club Youth competition to be played during the autumn. This competition will be played on a tournament basis, with each club hosting a tournament. All matches will be played in deep water pools; this will ensure good quality, highly competitive matches.

Boldmere SC has also entered an U14 team in the Nottingham Youth League which will take place in early 2011. This competition will also be played on a tournament basis, with teams from Grantham, Hucknall, Nottingham, and Hinckley.

The club will also defend the Midland Junior U18 League title starting in October 2010. After Christmas the club will complete in the Warwickshire County Championships.

I am sure you will appreciate that this is a challenging calendar, which will provide all our Youth and Junior players with plenty of opportunities to compete at a high level. To achieve this target, changes will be made to the coaching staff which should come into effect in October after the boom is fitted and the pool reopens.
